**AGREEMENT FOR CONDUCT OF EXECUTIVE  
POST GRADUATE PROGRAMME  
(SECURITY AND STRATEGIC STUDIES) COURSE  
BETWEEN  
ARMY WAR COLLEGE, MHOW AND  
PUNJABI UNIVERSITY, PATIALA**



**1. Agreement for conduct of Executive PG Programme (Security and Strategic Studies) Course**

This Agreement for conduct of Executive PG Programme (Security and Strategic Studies) made and entered into on Nov 2021 and between the following Institutions :-

- (a) **ARMY WAR COLLEGE, MHOW** which expression shall mean, and include its successors in interest and assigns of the first part (hereinafter referred to as AWC), and
- (b) **PUNJABI UNIVERSITY, PATIALA** which expression shall mean, and include its successors in interest and assigns of the second part (hereinafter referred to as Punjabi University, Patiala)

This agreement will **supersede** the agreement signed between both the parties on 02 July 2021.



2. **Name of the Course** : Executive PG Programme (Security and Strategic Studies)

The course will be conducted by Department of Defence and Strategic Studies, Punjabi University, Patiala in conjunction with Army War College, Mhow for officers undergoing Higher Command Course at Army War College, Mhow.

3. **Objectives of the Course** :

(a) To infuse conceptual understanding on theories of Security and Strategic Studies.

(b) To inculcate understanding on Regional and International Security Environment.

(c) To develop area specialisation through Term Paper preparation and report writing.

(d) To advance the issue based understanding on the subject through participatory Workshops and concept of research methodology & ethical publication.

4. **Duration of the Course** : The duration of Executive PG Programme (Security and Strategic Studies) will be spread over two semesters. It will be co-terminus with Higher Command Course.

5. If a candidate has passed the first semester examination but is unable to complete his course within one year, he shall be permitted to complete within a period of two years of his admission to the course.

6. **Eligibility** : A Defence Student Officer must fulfill the following conditions to be able to enroll for Executive PG Programme (Security and Strategic Studies) :-

(a) Should be of the rank of Colonel (or higher) / equivalent rank from Air Force / Navy or above so as to have the requisite experience in Defence and Security matters.

- (b) Should have Graduation degree in any discipline.
- (c) Should have obtained minimum marks at graduation level as per university requirement.
- (d) Should be attending Higher Command or equivalent Course at Army War College, Mhow or other Defence War College.
- (e) Should be carrying out research related duties or involved in imparting instructions in military related subjects or Defence Studies to student officers at Army War College, Mhow or other Defence War College.

7. **Mode of Admission** : The AWC will have the right to finalize the enrollment of the candidates for the Executive PG Programme and once so finalized, the Punjabi University shall accept the candidature based on the finalized list.

8. **Fee Structures** : Total fee of Rs 15000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only) per head or as decided by from time to time.

Mode of payment of Fees will be online to (online account details). The confirmation of payment will be shared with Basic DS, HC Wing.

9. **Vacancies** : The course will have vacancies for 120 officers. The officers are selected from all over India out of approx 40,000 officers to undergo Higher Command Course conducted at Mhow for the duration of 10 months. If the subscription of vacancy varies due to any reason, whatsoever, including but not limited to the exigencies of service, the same shall not entitle the Punjabi University to raise any claim, in any manner, whatsoever, on account of the variation in the stipulated vacancy of the course and the course fee payable shall be governed by the actual strength of the enrolled officer candidates at that time and the Punjabi University shall grant admission to the additional students, as and when required.



10. **Course of Study** : The course will be divided into two semesters.

10.1 **Semester-1 (12 Credits)**

The semester-1 will have three theoretical papers of 4 credits each.

Papers-I : Security and Strategic Studies: Theoretical Dimensions (The paper is aimed to study the theoretical framework debated / contested various schools of thoughts at international level)

Paper-II : Regional Security Environment in South Asia (The paper is aimed to develop understanding on regional geo-politics, regional strategic issues, societal and ethnic conflicts in the region, economic issues related to security etc)

Paper-III : International Security Environment (The paper is aimed to study international alignments, major conflict situations, economic dimensions of security, non-military threats etc)

10.2 **Evaluation of theory papers** :

Theory papers' evaluation will be based on the end semester examination.

10.3 **Semester-II (12 Credits)**

Paper –IV (4 Credits) Research Methodology & Publication Ethics (The paper is aimed to understand the process of research work and nuances of ethical way of publishing the researched thesis).

The Semester-2 will also have a Term paper of 08 Credits, which will be based on a research problem approved by Department of Defence and Strategic Studies, Punjabi University, Patiala and Army War College Mhow. The candidates will carryout the research work under the guidance of the Supervisor to prepare the Term Paper.

**10.4 Evaluation of theory papers and Examination :** There will be joint supervision of Executive PG Programme students in terms of the course work, writing of term paper including evaluation etc. Theory papers' evaluation will be based on the end semester examination. Comprehensive examination will be held at the end of Semester-I & Semester-II at AWC, Mhow in coordination with Punjabi University, Patiala, in accordance with the rules and regulations of Punjabi University, Patiala.

10.5 In Executive PG Programme examination, minimum pass Marks will be as decided by the Punjabi University. A **Gazette Notification** for each Executive PG Programme semester exam will be issued by the Punjabi University, Patiala from time to time.

11. **Term Paper** : A Term Paper to be presented by the candidate must be a piece of original research work characterized either by the discovery of new facts or by fresh interpretation of facts or theories and should show the candidate's capacity for critical examination and judgment and for lucid presentation. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that the Term Paper is free of plagiarism which means that no part of the Term paper has been copied from other sources and all sources used for this work have been properly cited. All students are required to check their research work through plagiarism detection software, Urkund as maintained by Army War College.

12. **Interactive Programme** : A visiting faculty of Department of Defence and Strategic Studies, Punjabi University, Patiala will visit Army War College, Mhow or through online medium during the workshop for three days. All travel, boarding and lodging arrangements will be provided by the Army War College, Mhow as per procedure / sanctioned grant and the same will not be claimed by the members of faculty from their present organization.

13. The qualified faculty will be drawn from Department of Defence and Strategic Studies, Punjabi University, Patiala / other school of studies, Army War College, Mhow and outside experts. The conduct of course, Semester exams, submission of term paper will be done at Army War College, Mhow which will further be forwarded to the Department of Defence and Strategic Studies, Punjabi University, Patiala.



14. **Duration and Amendment** : This MoU shall become effective from the date of signing / start of the academic year 2021-22 and will remain valid until either of the Institution may wish to terminate provided that the remaining institution gives written notice of its intention atleast six months prior to the termination date and that no activities already in progress are unduly affected by such termination. Further, any proposal to amend this memorandum may be made by either institution at any time will only take effect when mutual, written consent exists.


15. **Future Prospects**: The Qualified Executive PG Programme officers, who have already done Post-Graduation degree in Defence and Strategic Studies or allied subjects at the time of admission in this Executive PG Programme, will be exempted from Pre-PhD course work, in Defence and Strategic Studies at Punjabi University Patiala.

16. **Legal** : Except for the point as mentioned in Paragraph 14 above, there will be no legal implication of termination of the agreement on both parties.


17. **Dispute Settlement Clause** : In the event of a dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Memorandum of Understanding, its interpretation, or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof (a "dispute"), the Parties will use their best efforts to settle promptly such dispute through bilateral discussion. If any dispute that is not settled through bilateral discussion within sixty days from the date either Party has notified the other Party of the nature of the dispute and of the measures that should be taken to rectify, it shall be referred to Mediation at an Institution providing mediation services that is agreeable to both the parties. If the dispute is not settled by Mediation within 03 months of the appointment of the Mediator, or such further period as the parties shall agree in writing, the dispute shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Rules of Arbitration of the Indian Council of Arbitration and the award made in pursuance thereof shall be binding on the parties. The place of bilateral discussion, Mediation, Arbitration and / or any dispute resolution shall be Army War College Mhow or any other Venue as agreeable to both the parties.

18. **Data Confidentiality** : Punjabi University shall ensure the integrity and confidentiality of the data of the officer candidates derived during the process of the admission / course or provided otherwise. Furnishing of any material, data or information, could in its judgment, will be held as violation of policy regarding confidentiality of such information.




