Subject: Implementation of Minimum Qualifying Standards (MQS) for Athletics, Swimming, Shooting, and Archery from the Academic Year 2025–26 onwards

Sir/Madam,

The Association of Indian Universities (AIU), in its constant endeavour to improve the standard and quality of Inter-University Sports Competitions, has resolved to implement Minimum Qualifying Standards (MQS) for participation in certain individual events with effect from the academic year 2025–26.

In accordance with the provisions of the AIU Sports Handbook, Chapter XVI, Part VI, Minimum Qualifying Standards (Individual Events), Clause 16.16 (Direct All-India Championships), athletes participating in Athletics, Swimming, Shooting, Powerlifting and Archery will henceforth be required to achieve a minimum performance standard equivalent to the 16th-place performance in the previous year's All-India Inter-University Championship for that event.

Universities are therefore directed to ensure that only athletes who have achieved the prescribed MQS are fielded in these competitions. As further stipulated under Clause 16.19 (Penalty for Non-Compliance), if a University fields an athlete who does not meet the prescribed MQS, a penalty of ₹3,000 per athlete shall be imposed, and such penalty must be remitted before the University's further participation is allowed in AIU events.

The implementation of MQS from 2025–26 provides adequate time for universities to prepare their athletes accordingly, and it shall be the responsibility of each University to conduct appropriate trials and maintain verified records to ensure compliance.

This measure has been introduced with the objective of aligning Inter-University competitions with higher benchmarks, fostering merit-based participation, and providing meaningful competitive exposure to student-athletes.

Your cooperation and strict compliance with these guidelines is earnestly solicited.

Vide paper read above, the Indian Weight-Lifting Federation has informed the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) that they have Implemented new weight categories effective from 1st June 2025 for National/International Championship. The new weight categories are as follows: -

Senior (Age Group 17+ year)

Men (8): 60kg, 65kg, 71kg, 79kg, 88kg, 94kg, 110kg, +110kg Women (8): 48kg, 53kg, 58kg, 63kg, 69kg, 77kg, 86kg, +86kg

Indian Weight-Lifting Federation has further requested AIU to implement the same in the all competitions with effect from the academic year 2025-26 onwards.

Sanction has been accorded by the Hon'ble Secretary General, AIU to Implement the same in the Inter University Weight Lifting Championship from the academic year 2025-26 onwards
